  - Maria shared the story of a client of hers who had difficulty accessing county and nonprofit services. Referred to in the meeting as "Mr. Jones," Maria described a man who had a significant criminal background and was trying very diligently to make his life better to be the primary caretaker for his son who is three years old.
  - ii. Maria was put into contact with Mr. Jones because he expressed to is CALWORKS Program Social Worker that his partner was perpetrating domestic violence against him. The CALWORKS Social Worker has difficulty believing him initially because Mr. Jones' partner is a woman.
  - iii. Initially, Mr. Jones sought an emergency protective order against his partner. However, he was afraid that no one would believe him.
  - iv. When Maria first met him, Mr. Jones had scratches on his face. He described a physically, verbally, and emotionally abusive relationship

with his partner. He also said that he was in physically and verbally abusive relationship with a previous partner. His current partner also threatened to hurt his son.
